Need for Advance Care Planning



 Populations are aging, the burden of chronic illness is increasing, people are not prepared for decision making

- Advance care planning (ACP) is an important quality metric
 - It prepares patients & surrogates for medical decision making
 - Improves satisfaction with communication and care
 - Decreases surrogate burden, PTSD, complicated grief


- Identify what is most important and how they want to live

Proven Outcomes in Randomized Trials



RCTs: 1400 English/Spanish-Speaking Older Adults: Patientfacing → Primes Patients, Decreases Disparities







Directly observed visits:

~50% greater patient empowerment, clinician responsiveness

~50% increased real-time goal concordant care: 33% -> 59% \rightarrow




Decreases Health Disparities

California Advance Health Care Directive

This form lets you have a say about how you want to be cared for if you cannot speak for yourself.

This form has 3 parts:

Part 1: Choose a medical decision maker, Page 3

A medical decision maker is a person who can make health care decisions for you if you are not able to make them yourself.

They are also called a health care agent, proxy, or surrogate.

Part 2: Make your own health care choices, Page 6

This form lets you choose the kind of health care you want.

This way, those who care for you will not have to guess what you want if you are not able to tell them yourself.

Part 3: Sign the form, Page 11

The form must be signed before it can be used.



You can fill out Part 1, Part 2, or both.


Fill out only the parts you want. Always sign the form in Part 3.




